- <u>Syracuse University</u>: **status process in place**. Publicly engaged scholarship is a required part of the tenure and promotion process
- <u>University of Richmond</u>: **status in-process**. Links diversity, inclusion and equity to valuing publicly engaged scholarship efforts
- <u>University of Minnesota</u>: **status process in place**. Publicly engaged scholarship is a supplemental path, through either a holistic, teaching or scholarship review
- <u>University of Wisconsin</u>: **status process in place**. Publicly engaged scholarship is a supplemental path, with such scholars having the option to choose an integrated pathway of research, teaching and service
